

MEASURE 11: MANDATORY SENTENCING ONE STRIKE AND YOU'RE OUT!

If you are 15 years old or older this law applies to you!

WHAT IS MEASURE 11?

Measure 11 is the law in Oregon. This law says:

...IF you are 15 or older, and

...IF you do any of 21 crimes

THEN YOU GET TRIED AS AN ADULT!

And if you are convicted of any of these crimes...

THEN YOU WILL GET LOCKED UP!

WHY DOES OREGON HAVE THIS LAW?

Many Oregonians voted for this law because:

THEY ARE...

... Tired of crime

... Tired of anyone (including juveniles) getting away with crime

THEY WANT TO...

... Feel safe

... Be safe from violent crimes

... Lock up anyone (including juveniles) who commits certain crimes

WHO ARE YOU TALKING ABOUT . . . MURDERERS?

YES... Murder and Aggravated Murder will send even a 15 year old to prison BUT... There are 20 other crimes that WILL MOST LIKELY send a 15 year old to a lock up program or prison for a long time!

These are examples of Measure 11 crimes that could send you to prison:

ROBBERY I: You use a baseball bat, a gun, or a knife to threaten someone with serious physical injury in order to steal their bike. **You will go to prison for 7 years, 6 months.**

ROBBERY II: You tell someone that you have a gun and will shoot if they don't give you their money. The person reasonably believes you have a gun, even if you really don't, and gives you their money. **You will go to prison and could be there for 5 years and 10 months.**

SEXUAL ABUSE I: You are babysitting or playing with a small child. For the purpose of sexually gratifying yourself, you have sexual contact with them by touching their penis, vaginal area, or anus, or by making them touch you in those places. **You will go to prison and will be there for 6 years, 3 months.**

ASSAULT I: You seriously injure someone on purpose with a gun, a knife, a bat, or some other weapon. **You will go to prison, and will be there for 7 years, 6 months.**

MANSLAUGHTER II: You are driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. You cause an accident and someone dies. **You will go to prison and could stay there for 6 years, 3 months.**

DOING A CRIME MEANS BIG TIME!!

IF FOUND GUILTY OF ANY OF THESE MEASURE 11 CRIMES, YOU WILL DEFINITELY GO TO PRISON AND WILL STAY THERE FOR AT LEAST:

IF FOUND GUILTY OF THESE MEASURE 11 CRIMES, YOU WILL GO TO PRISON AND YOU MIGHT STAY THERE FOR:

IF I'M WITH SOMEONE AND THEY DO ONE OF THESE CRIMES, I WON'T GET IN TROUBLE...

WRONG! If you intentionally help that person commit the crime, like:

- ...Telling her to commit the crime
- ...Helping him plan the crime
- ...Being a lookout

THEN YOU COULD GET LOCKED UP TOO!

INSTEAD:

- ... Try to talk them out of it.
- ... Leave right away
- ... Get some help to stop the crime

WON'T THE JUDGE GIVE ME A BREAK IF I'VE NEVER BEEN IN TROUBLE BEFORE?
PROBABLY NOT! These are all serious crimes and Measure 11 usually requires that **EVERYONE**, including juveniles, be locked up for a long time if he or she is 15 or older and guilty of any of the 21 Measure 11 crimes.
