- classes will see Project Citizen portfolios on display

## Project Citizen (5<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> graders)

Portfolio display: Wednesday & Thursday, June 2-3, 9am to 3pm

Hearings: Thursday, June 3, 9am to 3pm (*optional*)

- portfolios on display in Capitol Galleria and judged by civic leaders
- classes may observe Project Citizen hearings by other schools
- top portfolio will go on display at national showcase this July in Louisville, KY
